

BOARDING RULES FOR RESIDENT STUDENTS

- 1. No student shall be off site at any time without the house parents prior knowledge and permission.
- 2. Boarders must be signed in and signed out on each vacation by an authorized adult. Any variance from this routine should be cleared with the house parent in advance.
- 3. A minimal quantity of tuck may be brought from home, although the following are forbidden in the interests of hygiene: sweets, chocolates, home made confectionary. Chewing gum is forbidden. Any small sums of pocket money should be deposited with the house parent. No valuables should be kept in school.
- 4. No electronic equipment (including mobile phones) is allowed.
- 5. Emails are allowed once a week. Phone calls are not allowed out of turn unless in case of emergency. All such calls must be directed through the house parent.
- 6. Please inform your house parent and infirmary about any medicine that your child may be taking.
- 7. Leave may be sanctioned only through written communication.
- 8. No bullying, physical or verbal, will be tolerated.
- 9. Punctual observance of the boarding and academic timetables is required.
- 10.Each student is expected to be credit to the school, to strive for academic excellence and to be motivated by consideration for others in the boarding environment. Needless to say, real commitment for studies, participation in school activities and exemplary conduct are required at all times.
- 11. Medical book should be duly filled.
